- 300mm Concrete Storm Sewer 700m
- 375mm Concrete Storm Sewer 1300m
- 450mm Concrete Storm Sewer 1200m
- 525mm Concrete Storm Sewer 510m
- 600mm Concrete Storm Sewer 615m
- 675mm Concrete Storm Sewer 420m
- 750mm Concrete Storm Sewer 100m
- 825mm Concrete Storm Sewer 15m
- 900mm Concrete Storm Sewer 430m
- 1050mm Concrete Storm Sewer 150m
- 200mm Sanitary sewer & associated manholes 150m
- Catch basins 160
- Manholes 80
- Non return Flap gate/Sliding gate chambers
- Lowering of existing 150-300mm diameter watermains (Fifteen (15) storm sewer/watermain conflict locations)
- Including abandonment and removal of existing manholes/catchbasins and sewers and appurtenances and restoration.
