World Hepatitis Day

On July 28th Niagara Health's-Hepatitis C Care Clinic will be recognizing World Hepatitis Day. This year a community event will be held at Montebello Park in St. Catharines.

The Hepatitis C Care Clinic, which is part of the Niagara Health - Mental Health and Addictions Program, is funded through the Ministry of Health, Hepatitis C Secretariat.

The program mandate is to provide care to the marginalized population, which may "fall between the cracks" of the health care and social services systems to provide a "safety net" to ensure everyone receives the care they need when they need it.

Hepatitis B and C are two life-threatening liver diseases and that is why we recognize that a key goal of each year's World Hepatitis Day event is to encourage Niagara residents to get tested and know their status, especially because of the new, highly effective and tolerable therapies for Hepatitis C that are now available.
